NATURE & CRAFT

Explore. Create. Play. Gather.

Program Overview

Nature & Craft is a single-day immersive experience that blends outdoor adventure, creative expression, and environmental education. Delivered on or off campus, the program runs for 4 to 8 hours and can be customised by age group, learning goals, and group size. It combines eco-awareness learning, outdoor activities, artistic and cultural experiences, team bonding, and hands-on environmental stewardship.

Four Program Pillars

1

EXPLORE

Outdoor discovery through nature walks, eco hunts, and observation activities.

2

CREATE

Adire tie and dye, earth-color art, upcycled crafts, and group murals.

3

PLAY

Relay races, team sports, obstacle challenges, and cooperative activities.

4

GATHER

Story circles, bonfire gatherings, music, and reflection sessions.

Program Modules

Eco-Awareness Session

Curriculum-aligned intro to sustainability, waste, biodiversity, and climate action.

Nature Discovery

Guided nature walk, observation journals, texture and sound mapping, scavenger hunt.

Adire & Creative Heritage

Hands-on adire tie and dye workshop exploring Nigerian textile traditions and nature-inspired motifs.

Camping Experience

Tent setup demonstration, team-based camp challenge, outdoor safety, and camp etiquette.

Sports & Team Recreation

Sack races, relay competitions, tug of war, football mini-games, cooperative challenges.

Bonfire & Reflection

Storytelling, music, group sharing on environmental responsibility, and closing ceremony.

LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT

Structured challenges that grow confident, collaborative young leaders.

Program Overview

Leadership Development is a high-engagement program for older students, especially SS1 to SS3, prefects, student council members, and emerging peer influencers. Delivered as a 3 to 6 hour experience on or off campus, the program uses practical activities, simulations, and guided reflection to strengthen confidence, teamwork, communication, initiative, and service-minded leadership. Rather than motivational talks alone, participants practice leadership in real time.

Six Leadership Pillars

1

SELF-LEADERSHIP

Managing attitude, conduct, emotions, and personal discipline.

2

COMMUNICATION

Speaking clearly, listening actively, and representing others well.

3

COLLABORATION

Working with peers, resolving tension, and contributing to a team goal.

4

INITIATIVE

Stepping forward and solving problems without constant supervision.

5

RESPONSIBILITY

Owning tasks and understanding that leadership is service.

6

RESILIENCE

Handling pressure, adapting, and recovering from setbacks.

Program Modules

Leadership Mindset

Reframes leadership as influence, service, discipline, and credibility rather than status or title.

Team Challenge Circuit

Timed problem-solving tasks, strategy races, trust challenges, and leadership rotation under pressure.

Decision-Making Simulation

Discipline scenarios, peer-pressure cases, event coordination, and ethics and consequence mapping.

Reflection & Commitment Circle

Leadership journaling, peer affirmations, commitment cards, team recognition, and closing charge.

Identity & Strengths Mapping

Guided self-awareness: strengths, blind spots, values mapping, and peer perception activity.

Communication & Influence Lab

Public speaking drills, active listening, message relay, conflict role-play, and confident direction-giving.

Service & School Culture

Leadership as service, protecting school culture, using influence positively, and integrity in representation.

Program Overview

2-Day On-Campus Camps transforms familiar school grounds into a safe, exciting environment for adventure, learning, teamwork, and personal growth.
